TRANSPORTATION RULES & RESPONSIBILITIES

The Out-of-Door Academy operates a bus service for the purpose of transporting students to and from school. This service is maintained for the sole convenience of students and families of the school.

PARENT AND STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Transportation charges may be paid at the time of registration or by selecting one of the payment plans offered.
2. Riders are expected to be at their appointed stop five (5) minutes before the bus arrives; buses leave the appointed stop at the time listed on the Transportation Schedule; busses cannot wait. If there is a discrepancy on time please check with the driver or the Transportation Coordinator.
3. Parents, please discuss and reinforce student responsibilities for proper conduct on the buses. These responsibilities are for the safety of the driver as well as all passengers on the bus. Should a problem occur, please contact the Transportation Coordinator, or the Head of the Upper or Lower School as appropriate.
4. The Out-of-Door transportation ID tags must be attached to student backpacks to guarantee busing service.
5. If you are planning to have an Out-of-Door student-visitor ride home with your student, first check with the Transportation Coordinator to determine availability of an extra seat. The student's teacher must inform the front office. The front office will provide a permission form for the student-visitor to provide to the bus driver.

BUS RIDER CODE OF CONDUCT-

- 1) **Students and parents must be on time.** The bus cannot wait for tardy students or parents.
- 2) The bus driver is in charge of the bus and the safety of the students at all times. Students are required to treat the bus driver with respect and must obey the bus driver's instructions at all times.
- 3) Outside of ordinary conversation, classroom conduct is to be observed on the bus. Inappropriate language and/or gestures, the physical or mental harassment of another student, wrestling and/or fighting, the throwing of objects on the bus or any activity deemed to create a safety hazard will result in disciplinary action and possible suspension of riding privileges as determined by the Lower School Head and/or Upper School Dean of Students.
- 4) The buses are equipped with seat belts. Students are required to wear seat belts at all times when the engine is running.
- 5) Students are to remain in their seats at all times. Students are not to extend or throw anything through the open bus windows.
- 6) The Lower School Head and/or Upper School Dean of Students have the authority to assign seating as deemed necessary.
- 7) If a shuttle bus nears its capacity load, the Lower School Head and/or Upper School Dean of Students have the authority to assign students to another route with the same destination point, even if that means the student will be arriving at the final destination at a later time.
- 8) No food, beverage or chewing gum may be opened or consumed on the bus. Students are allowed to bring bag lunches as long as they remain closed.
- 9) While waiting for the bus, students should stand clear of the road and pick-up area. Students will be allowed to load the bus only after the driver has given his/her consent.
- 10) Upon exiting the bus, students must first receive acknowledgement from the bus driver before crossing the road. The student shall cross no less than ten feet in front of the bus.
- 11) The bus driver will not discharge any PK – 6th grade student unless the parent or responsible party is present. If the parent or responsible party is not at the drop-off point, the bus driver will wait for 10 minutes. If the parent or responsible party does not arrive, the student will be transported to the Siesta Key campus and placed in the After School Day Care program. Parents will be responsible for applicable after-care charges. Three documented incidents of pick up tardiness will result in immediate suspension of riding privileges.
